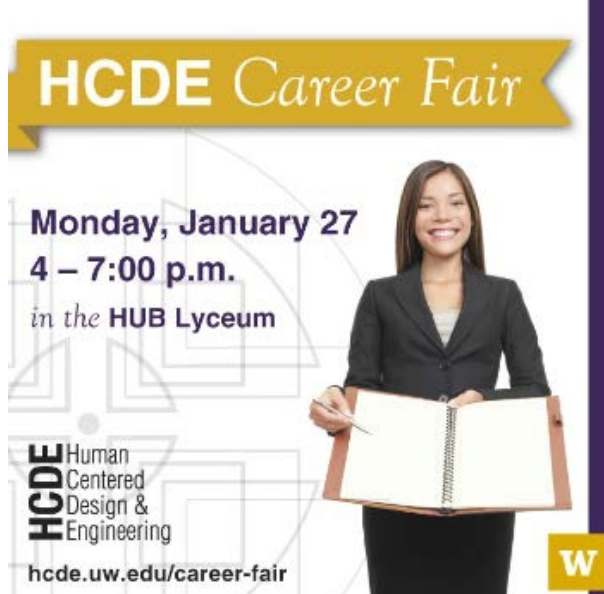

PROFESSORS JUDY RAMEY AND DAVID FARKAS

SERVED THE DEPARTMENT FOR 30 YEARS

HCDE Professors Judy Ramey and David Farkas began teaching with the University of Washington in 1983, but 2013 marked their last quarter with the department. Both Ramey and Farkas were pioneers in the fields of technical communication and human centered design, and their contributions will long be remembered.

As announced at Farkas's retirement party last fall, **HCDE alumnus and good friend James Prekeges proposed the David Farkas Endowment Fund to honor Farkas' legacy.
